Meeting Minutes • August 20, 2016 :

- There is a plan to have an Inter District Conference (IDC) among the districts of the BLD Newark cluster in June 2017. One major item to be addressed is the sharing of resources among the districts during our encounters. The IDC will include an implementation plan on agreed-upon items.
- BLD Newark calendar for next year will be disseminated to other districts in the BLD Newark cluster once it is completed. The plan is to complete the calendar for the following year by the end of November of the current year.
- It is recommended that all the ministries, which handle encounters/retreats requiring an outside venue, be reminded to start scheduling the date of the events for the following year. This allows for a timely search for a venue and the start of contract negotiations together with the scheduling of the event spiritual director.
- There is a plan to undertake an evaluation of a two-day Marriage Encounter to determine the feasibility of its implementation in BLD Newark.
- There is a need to continue our search for other venues for our encounters, preferably retreat houses.

- The list of sharers for the BLD Allentown LSS on September 10 & 11 was finalized. Preparations are proceeding, including the shepherds/lambs matching, praise support, moment-to-moment schedule, others.
- The new coordinators for the LSA ministry are Earl & Flo Manguiat.

 They will be replacing Lito & Gigi Vibar who have decided to step aside.

LSS weekend -

There is a need to re-establish our practice of limiting the number of people in the venue during the LSS weekend. Those who want to volunteer as auxies will be required to sign up beforehand.

Implementation of color-coded IDs (or color stickers on ID) will enable the LSS team to identify individuals and their functions easily. Instruct SP/SE/LSA Teams to disseminate this information to all their members. This is intended to enhance crowd control, facilitate planning and preparations for the LSS.
