<b>2</b>	<b>FE as an ENTRY POINT to BLD Membership</b>	<p>DCS carefully reviewed the BLD Statutes <b>Article 3, Section 3:</b> An individual, couple, or family who desires to join the BLD Covenant Community must have been baptized and confirmed according to the rites of the Roman Catholic Church and must have complied with other requirements at entry point.</p> <p>Section 4.1: Regular Membership. The entry points to Regular Membership are the Encounter Program, LSS, or through any</p>

		<p>program as determined by the competent authority of the BLD Community. Section 4.4: Participation in BLD Community programs and activities is also open to those who are non-Catholics, in accord with the norms of the law.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DCS agreed <b>to implement</b>, based on the statutes, that FE is an entry point to BLD membership for as long as the family meets the requirements stated in the statutes.</li> </ul>

10	<b>BLD 2016 Statutes</b>	CS reviewed the preliminary documents on the 2016 New BLD Statutes and related /pertinent documents with the group.  We will be moving all pertinent documents, including guidelines, to our website so that all members will have easy access and can review them.
11	<b>Trinidad Family Tragic Car Accident</b>	Trinidad Family is not a member of BLD, but this was a very distressing event that a lot of members were saddened and greatly affected by it. The family needs a lot of prayers. Prayers will help them go through this very difficult trial.  DCS requested Intercessory Ministry and all Pastoral Apostolate ministries (Mark 10, John 6, Youth, Solo Parents and Singles Ministries) to include them in their supplication prayers and to have a one-minute moment of silence for this family this Friday.  An email was also sent to all members of the community requesting to pray for the family and indicated that if they wish to donate, they can send it through GoFundMe, and the link was provided.  Susie Atienza, friend of the mother, also mentioned that members may send donations directly to Lydia Anas (aunt of the mother), 79 Herrick Avenue, Teaneck NJ 07666.  FYI: There is a total of over 260K donated already through GoFundMe.
