**Week#2** (6<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Theme: We receive fullness of life when we forgive others out of love and compassion.

Promise: "Blessed is he whose fault is taken away, whose sin is covered." (Ps 32:1)

Order: *"Be imitators of Me."* (1 Cor 11:1)

**Week#3** (1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent)

Theme: We receive fullness of life when we repent and firmly believe in the gospel.

Promise: "The Lord shows the sinners the way. He guides the humble to justice, he teaches the humble his way." (Ps 25:8-9)

Order: *Repent, and believe in the gospel.* (Mk 1:15b)

Directions:

  - Make active effort to give up sinful habits by reading scripture, fasting, almsgiving and praying.
  - Persevere in inviting others to attend mass, teachings, retreats, and corporate worship.

Theme We receive fullness of life when we listen to God's voice to transform us.  
Promise: "I will bless you abundantly...because you obeyed my command."  
(Gn 22:17a, 18b)  
Order: "*Listen to Him.*" (Mk 9:7b)
