Week#1 - (Feast of the Presentation of the Lord)

DIRECTION:

- Spend time in adoration and offer your burdens and pains before the Blessed Sacrament.

PROMISE: *"... He is able to help those who are tested."* (Hb 2:18b)

Week#2 - (5th Sunday in Ordinary Time) 1st Friday Eucharistic Celebration

THEME: We are sanctified when we render works of mercy.

ORDER: *"...your light must shine before others..."* (Mt 5:16a)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Be loving and compassionate to those who are suffering and bear each other's burden.
2. Be faithful and obey the commandments of the Lord.

PROMISE: *"Lavishly he gives to the poor, his justice shall endure forever, his horn shall be exalted in glory."* (Ps 112:9)

Week#3 - (6th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

THEME: We are sanctified when we obey and teach God's commandment.

ORDER: *"Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.' Anything more is from the evil one."* (Mt 5:37)

DIRECTION: Remain a faithful witness to the Living Word.

PROMISE: *"...trust in God. You too shall live."* (Sir 15:15b)

Week#4 - (7th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

THEME: We are sanctified when we love our neighbor unconditionally and pray for those who persecute us.

ORDER: *“Take no revenge and cherish no grudge against any of your people. You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” (Lv 19:18)*

DIRECTIONS:

- Be patient, kind and merciful.
- Reach out and reconcile with those you hurt or have hurt you.

PROMISE: *“He pardons all your iniquities...He crowns you with kindness and compassion.” (Ps 103:3-4)*
