COMMUNITY WORD

ORDER:

“This is my chosen Son, listen to him.” (Lk 9:35)

PROPHECIES:

- 1. I am the Lord your God; trust in My mercy and in My unconditional love for you.
- 2. Strengthen your faith in Me and stand firm in your belief.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Be reconciled with God; repent of your sins and go to confession. Pray, fast and give to charity.
- 2. Reform your ways; do what is pleasing to God and bear much fruit.
- 3. Persevere in the study of the word of God and live by example.

Week#1 - (1st Sunday of Lent) March 6, 2022

Theme: Our faith in Jesus, God’s chosen Son, strengthens us to resist temptation.

Order: *“You shall worship the Lord, your God, and Him alone shall you serve.” (Lk 4:8)*

Directions:

- Faithfully pray and worship in unity and fellowship as one community.

- Be active in Ministry service.

Promise: “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” (Rom 10:13)

Week#2 - (2nd Sunday of Lent) March 13, 2022

Theme: Our faith in Jesus, God’s chosen Son, brings us to listen to Him to transform our life.

Order: “*This is my chosen Son; listen to him.*” (Luke 9:35)

Directions:

- Set aside peaceful, quiet, unhurried time for prayer.
- Read and reflect on the Word daily.

Promise: “He will change our lowly body to conform with His glorified body.” (Phil 3:21a)

Week#3 - (3rd Sunday of Lent) March 20, 2022

Theme: Our faith in Jesus, God’s chosen Son, leads us to repentance and fruitfulness.

Order: “*I tell you, if you do not repent, you will all perish as they did!*” (Luke 13:3)

Directions:

- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- Do works of mercy.

Promise: “He redeems your life from destruction, crowns you with kindness and compassion.” (Ps 103:4)

Week#4 - (4th Sunday of Lent) March 27, 2022

Theme: Our faith in Jesus, God’s chosen Son, allows us to be reconciled with God and receive His graces.

Order: “*... be reconciled to God*” (2 Cor 5:20b)

Directions:

- Attend Community retreats, encounters and events for healing and reconciliation.
- As a community, let us be welcoming to all members.

Promise:

“You are here with me always, everything I have is yours.” (Lk 15:31)
