**READINGS**

**COMMUNITY WORD**

Jesus' sacrificial love is our redemption and the way to a renewed life.

**ORDER:**

"Go, and from now on do not sin anymore." (Jn 8:11b)

**PROPHECIES:**

1. Repent and turn away from the temptations of the world, and live in My Spirit.
2. Put your trust in My Son, Jesus, who is the Perfecter of your faith.
3. Grow in your love for Me; as you serve the needs of others, you serve Me.

**DIRECTIONS:**

1. Find time to be silent with the Lord and listen to Him.
2. Regularly examine the condition of your heart and go to confession.
3. Honor and fulfill your covenant with the Lord.

**WEEKLY THEME, ORDER, PROMISE and DIRECTION (TODP)**

Week#1 (5th Sunday of Lent)

Theme: We are redeemed towards a new life when we acknowledge our sins and repent.

Promise: "Those that sow in tears shall reap rejoicing." (Ps 126:5)

Order: "Go and from now on do not sin anymore" (Jn 8: 11B)

Direction/s: Repent and journey with Christ on the road to calvary.

**Week#2 (Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion)**

Theme: We are redeemed towards a new life when we are humble and obedient to God's will.

Promise: "The Lord God is my help...I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame." (Is 50:7)

Order: "Get up and pray that you may not undergo the test" (Lk 22:46)

Direction/s:

1. Be obedient to our covenant with the Lord by coming together in praise and worship every Friday.
2. Be united in worship, prayer, and fellowship as a community.

**Week#3 (Easter Sunday) (April 15, Good Friday - No Praise & Worship - Instead, Online via Zoom. Stations of the Cross)**

Theme: We are redeemed towards a new life when we rejoice in Christ's resurrection.  
Promise: "When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory." (Col 3:4)

Order: "Seek what is above....not of what is on earth" (Col. 3:1-2)

Direction/s:

1. Rejoice and celebrate in our new life with the resurrected Christ in prayer, worship and service.

**Week#4 (Divine Mercy Sunday, 2nd Sunday of Easter)**

Theme: We are redeemed towards a new life when we believe in the merciful love of Jesus.  
Promise: "...come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name." (Jn 20:31)

Order: "Do not be unbelieving, but believe" (Jn 20:27)

Direction:

1. Believe that God's love and mercy has defeated this global crisis. Come out and serve.
