**COMMUNITY WORD**

**ORDER**

*“Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you.”* (2 Cor 13:11)

**DIRECTIONS**

1. Turn away from your habitual sins and reconcile with God and your neighbors.
2. Find spiritual nourishment and strength in the daily partaking of the Eucharist.

**PROPHECIES**

1. Be united with Me in love; I will pardon your sins and give you peace.
2. Endure your suffering for the salvation of many; be My light.

## THEMES AND PROMISES

### Week#1 (Solemnity of the Holy Trinity) – First Friday Eucharistic Celebration

**Theme:** We live in solidarity in our desire to be holy when we believe in the fellowship of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

**Order:** *“Mend your ways, encourage one another, agree with one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you.”* (2 Cor 13:11)

**Direction:** Participate in daily novenas, rosaries and devotional prayers.

**Promise:** *“...everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.”* (Jn 3: 16b)

### Week#2 (Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ) – Praise and Worship

**Theme:** We live in solidarity in our desire to be holy when we partake in the Holy Eucharist with a pure heart.

**Order:** *“Do not forget the LORD, your God...”* (Dt 8:14b)

**Directions:**

1. Attend virtual Mass and partake of the Spiritual Communion as many times during the day.
2. Read more the Scripture in this time of isolation.
3. Keep His commandments.

**Promise:** *“Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him.”* (Jn 6:56)

### Week#3 (12th Sunday in Ordinary Time) – Praise and Worship

**Theme:** We live in solidarity in our desire to be holy when we have the courage to testify to others what Jesus has done in our life.

**Order:** *“... do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body...”* (Mt 10 :28)

**Directions:**

1. Take courage to choose the right when tempted to do wrong.
2. Confess that Jesus is the Lord and our Savior.

**Promise:** *“Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father.”* (Mt 10:32)

### Week#4 (13th Sunday in Ordinary Time) – Praise and Worship

**Theme:** We live in solidarity in our desire to be holy when we make Christ the center in all our relationships.

**Order:** *“... think of yourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus.”* (Rom 6:11)

**Directions:**

1. Evangelize and be a witness of God’s love so that many will be transformed.
2. Sustain your spiritual life through prayers, daily reading of God’s word, say the Act of Contrition with the intention of receiving the sacrament of Penance when it becomes available.
3. Partake of Spiritual communion as often as possible.
4. Perform spiritual acts of mercy.

**Promise:** *“Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.”*  
(Mt 10: 39)
