Week#1 (14th Sunday in Ordinary Time) **July 5 ~ First Friday Eucharistic Celebration**

Theme	Disciples of Christ are empowered when they perform mission work.
Order	<i>"Come and see the works of God..." (Ps 66:5)</i>
Directions	1) Be a living witness of God's transforming love and power by the way you think, speak and act. 2) Show your concern for others through caring words and generosity.
Promise	<i>"...rejoice because your names are written in heaven." (Lk 10:20b)</i>

Week#2 (15th Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ July 14, 2019)

Theme	Disciples of Christ are empowered when they show mercy and compassion.
Order	<i>"You shall love the Lord, your God, ... and your neighbor as yourself." (Lk 10:27)</i>
Directions	1) Help and assist one another unconditionally. 2) Be of God's handiwork and actively do the full meaning of universal love.
Promise	<i>"The Lord hears the poor, and his own who are in bonds, he spurns not." (Ps 69:34)</i>

Week#3 (16th Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ July 21, 2019)

Theme	Disciples of Christ are empowered when they reflect on God's word and serve others.
Order	<i>"...minister in accordance with God's stewardship..." (Col 1:25)</i>
Directions	1. Go regularly for Eucharistic Adoration 2. Start your day with daily scripture readings and reflections. 3. Glorify the Lord through your service.
Promise	<i>"One who walks blamelessly and does justice, who thinks the truth in his heart...shall never be disturbed." (Ps. 15:2, 5b)</i>

Week#4 (17 Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ July 28, 2019)

Theme	Disciples of Christ are empowered when they persistently intercede for others.
Order	<i>"Ask...seek...knock..." (Lk 11:9)</i>
Direction	Persevere in your prayers and intercede for one another.
Promise	<i>"For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." (Lk 11:10)</i>
