Week#1 - (27th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

(2Tim 1:13)*

DIRECTIONS: 1. Be the light of Christ in your circle of influence and inspire others of God’s faithfulness to His word.
2. Be persistent in serving the Lord in the tasks/ assignments given to you.

PROMISE: *“For the vision has its time...it will surely come, it will not be late.”
(Hb 2:3)*

Week#2 - (28th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

THEME: We have unwavering faith when we are grateful for God’s kindness.

ORDER: ... *“...Give thanks to God.” Lk 17:18b*

DIRECTIONS: 1. Regularly pause to thank God for any and all circumstances.
2. Use the charisms you received by serving through the community and parish.

PROMISE: *“...live with him...he remains faithful.” (2Tim 2: 11-13)*

Week#3 - (29th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

THEME: We have unwavering faith when we meditate on God’s word and persevere in prayer.

ORDER: *“...Pray always without becoming weary.” Lk 18:1b*

DIRECTIONS: 1. Encourage others to join us in prayer during our Praise & Worship.
2. Reflect on His Living Word regularly for guidance.

PROMISE: *“The Lord will guard your coming and your going, both now and forever.” (Ps 121:8)*

Week#4 – (30th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

THEME: We have unwavering faith when we humbly acknowledge our sinfulness and depend on God’s mercy.

ORDER: “Be merciful...” Lk 18:13b

- DIRECTIONS:**
1. Go to confession regularly.
 2. Pray with a contrite heart.
 3. Intercede & provide for the needs of the poor and lowly.

PROMISE: “The Lord is close to the broken-hearted; and those who are crushed in spirit he saves.” (Ps 34: 19)
