COMMUNITY WORD

ORDER

"Repent for the kingdom of God is at hand ... prepare the way of the lord, make straight his paths." (Matthew 3:2-3)

PROPHECIES

1. I, the Lord, will do good things for you who truly repent & believe in Me.
2. Prepare for My coming and be an instrument of My love and peace.
3. I am the true Light; I will guide you to the right path.

DIRECTIONS

1. Reconcile with God and others; confess your sins and reform your ways.
2. Share your blessings and be charitable to the needy and the marginalized.
3. Reflect on the joyful season and let Jesus shine in all celebrations.
4. Pray for world peace and conversion of sinners.

THEMES / PROMISES / ORDERS / DIRECTIONS

Week#1 (1st Sunday of Advent) 11/27/22

Theme: Our salvation is at hand when we live in holiness as we prepare for Christ's coming.

Promise: "For our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed." (Romans 13:11b)

Order: be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come (Matthew 24:44)

Direction: Practice discipline in prayers, reconciliation and in receiving the Holy Eucharist.

Week#2 (2nd Sunday of Advent) 12/04/22

Theme: Our salvation is at hand when we truly repent for our sins and bear good fruit.

Promise: "Justice shall flourish in his days, and profound peace." (Psalm 72:7)

Order: "Repent for the kingdom of God is at hand... prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." (Matthew 3:2-3)

Direction: Reconcile with God and others; confess your sins and reform your ways.

Week#3 (3rd Sunday of Advent) 12/11/22

Theme: Our salvation is at hand when we joyfully accept Jesus as our Savior.

Promise: "Here is your God, he comes with vindication; with divine recompense he comes to save you." (Isaiah) 35:4b)

Order: Be strong, fear not. (Isaiah 35:4)

Direction: Be patient brothers and sisters until the coming of the Lord.

Week#4 (4th Sunday of Advent) 12/18/22

Theme: Our salvation is at hand when we are obedient to God's will and plan.

Promise: "He shall receive a blessing from the Lord, a reward from God his savior." (Psalm 24:5)

Order: "Do not be afraid" (Matthew 1:20a)

Direction/s:

1. Be obedient and trust in the Lord.
2. Make a conscious decision to attend Mass regularly, serve in Community and attend teachings.

Week#5 (Christmas Day) 12/25/22

Theme: Our salvation is at hand when we experience God's fullness of grace.

Promise: "All the ends of the earth will behold the salvation of our God." (Isaiah 52:10b)

Order: "Testify to the light, so that all might believe." (John 1:7)

Direction:

1. Bring glad tidings, announce peace, bear good news and proclaim salvation.

Week#6 (Feast of the Holy Family) 12/30/22

Theme: Our salvation is at hand when we let the peace of Christ control our hearts

Promise: Blessed are all who fear the LORD. (Psalm 128:1)

Order: "be considerate of him; revile him not all the days of his life" (Sirach 3:13)

Direction: Honor thy father and thy mother.
